

### A Note on First/Second Aorist -μι Verbs

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Mounce, *BBG*, 368, gives six paradigms of second aorist -μι verbs—*almost none of which occur in the NT!* For the forms that do occur, they are almost all *first aorist* forms. (He does give the correct forms of δίδωμι on p. 324.) Use this page to *replace* p. 368. Forms that do not occur in the NT are marked with a –.

Most of the forms that are given here occur very infrequently in the NT (often only 1–4× each). The only forms that occur more than a dozen times are the 3S of δίδωμι (ἔδωκεν, 64×) and ἴστημι (ἔστησεν, 16×).
